The Learn To Skate USA program being offered by the Skating Club of Southern N.E. is an excellent introduction into USFS Figure Skating for any child or adult wanting to learn how to skate or advance in USFS. Designed by U.S. Figure Skating, the Learn To Skate USA Program is an ice skating program that is fun, challenging and rewarding. Each class consists of a 25 minute lesson and 25 minute practice with instructors. Skaters will be taught by our USFS professional staff. These classes consist of beginner through advanced levels. The classes are designed for beginner hockey and figure skating.

Skaters should dress warm and be comfortable with mittens/gloves. HECC certified helmets are strongly recommended for first time skaters. Only single blade skates are allowed. Rentals are available at an additional cost through the rink office.

In October the SC of SNE will invite all our skaters to perform in our Holiday Exhibition on December 15th (small additional fee).
